Multiple Choice Question examination

The MCQ examination will be conducted before the Oral examination. The assessment of this MCQ will be proportional, i.e. the final points given are in relation to correct answers. The total number of MCQs is 50. One answer out of four per question will be correct; there will be no negative points. EBOMFS reserves the right to analyse statistically MCQ results and to omit a question if it is non-selective. All participants will sit the oral examination. Candidates not taking the MCQ will not be admitted to take part to the oral examination.

The MCQ examination will be held in English.

Oral examination

- a) Case report. Each candidate must be ready to present three well documented personal cases using an electronic platform. The jury will select one to be presented by the candidate **within 5 minutes**, followed by a discussion of another 5 minutes. The candidate should bring his/her PPT presentation on a USB stick. No personal laptop or tablet will be allowed.
- b) Questions and discussion covering the whole scope of the specialty (35 minutes).

The total duration of the assessment may not exceed 45 minutes.

The languages used in the oral examination are English, French, German, Italian or Spanish.

At least one of the 3 jury members will be physically present, 1 or 2 jury members may be present online.
